TOTM is the latest creation by artist Didier Mouron. It is a revolutionary "Off-the-Wall" Idea for Displaying Art. Briefly described, it is a free standing sculpture designed for the display of artwork.

The flexibility of TOTM allows for exhibitions in both conventional and unusual locations by moving artwork from walls to open space. The design also incorporates an independent self-powered lighting system for museum-quality illumination.

DIDIER MOURON



Didier Mouron is an internationally known artist who was born in Mont Pelerin, Switzerland. He has been creating his specialized type of graphite artwork for over 30 years and has had enough success to be able to "live by his pencil". He has exhibited his work throughout Europe since 1983.

This is his third return to North America since living and working in a wilderness area of Canada for 10 years. Didier has exhibited at the opening of the NY Trump Tower as well as in Chicago, Atlanta, Dallas, Miami, Phoenix, and Los Angeles and has also worked as a professor for the prestigious Swiss sister school of the Pasadena Art Design Center for several years during the 1980's.

Didier's art is spiritually motivated. He is inspired by the subconscious and his world of dreams. He will typically wake up in the middle of the night to work with each piece requiring 100's of hours of his time. Works in progress are discarded rather than erase a single pencil stroke. This uncompromising approach defines his art, portraying his emotions through millions of nuanced pencil strokes.
